**Note:** You will not receive any confirmation of the successful activation of your account. Simply go to the computer lab and try whether you have access to SCILAB/STATA.

**Please do not write mails to the above mentioned address whether your activation has been successful! Your activation will NOT be confirmed by mail.**

### **3 Information about using your own laptop**
