## Position for Doctoral Studies in International Economics

The Chair of International Finance at the University of Mainz, Germany, invites applications for a doctoral position in international economics, with starting date April 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 or the earliest date thereafter.

The ideal candidate is currently completing a graduate program or master studies, has a strong formal background and intends to combine model-based theory with empirical work. Possible topics of interest include exchange rate dynamics, trade and labor markets or international aspects of environmental economics.

Teaching duties are two academic hours per week (a TA session per term, with two terms per year). Working knowledge of German is an asset but not a requirement.

Applications should be sent electronically to <u>internationalfinance@uni-mainz.de</u> and include a cover letter, a resume, a sample of academic writing and a sketch of a research plan. The review of applications begins immediately and continues until the position is filled.
